The Beginner's Guide to the Exodus Wallet (On Mobile)

Now, before diving into the tutorial, you should know...

What is the Exodus wallet?

The Exodus wallet is a self-custodial software wallet, meaning it gives you complete control over your digital assets and is managed through a simple software app.

It supports over 250 cryptocurrencies, so it will likely be able to manage most of the digital assets you secure.

Once you set up the Exodus wallet and secure your digital assets inside of it, you can access those assets on ANY computer anywhere in the world. As long as you have your secret 12-word phrase and password (which you'll create in this tutorial), you can "restore" an Exodus wallet and recover all of your assets.

So, don't worry if your computer breaks or is stolen or anything else. Your crypto is safe as long as you keep your 12-word phrase and password safe.

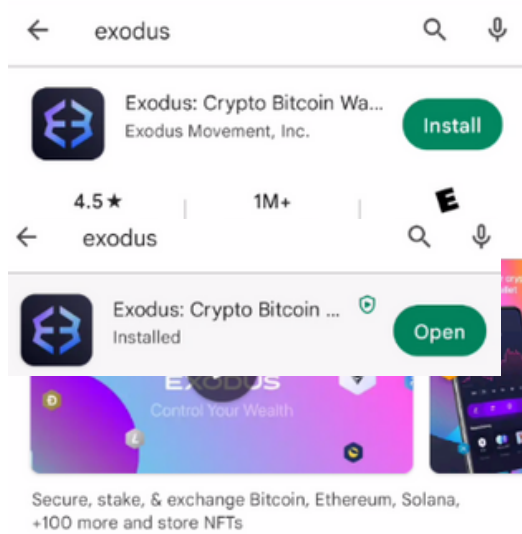

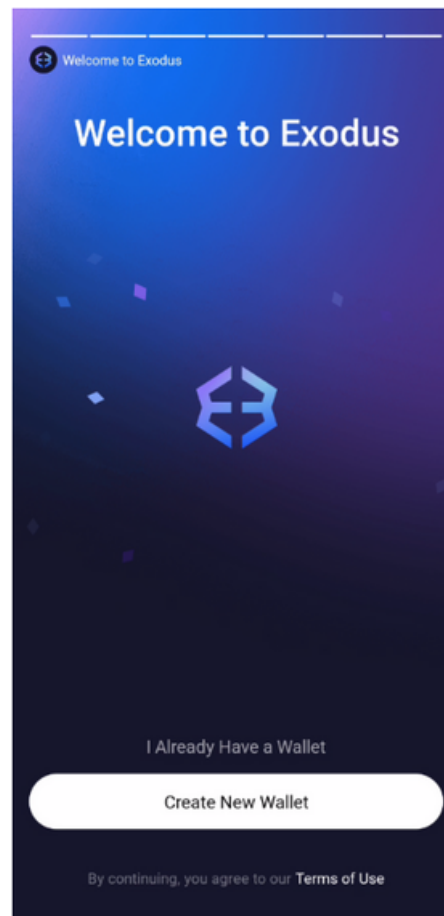


How to download and install the Exodus wallet on your mobile

Step 1: Go to the app store on your device (Google Play Store or Apple App Store), search for Exodus Wallet and then install the Exodus app then open it.



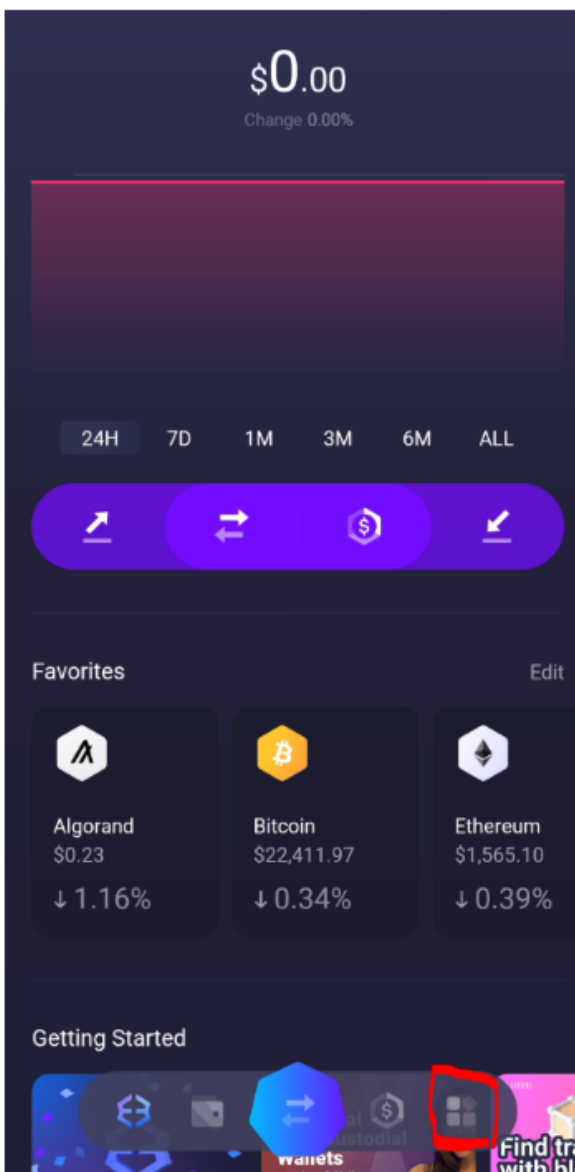
Step 2: Allow the Exodus app to load up and then click "Create New Wallet".



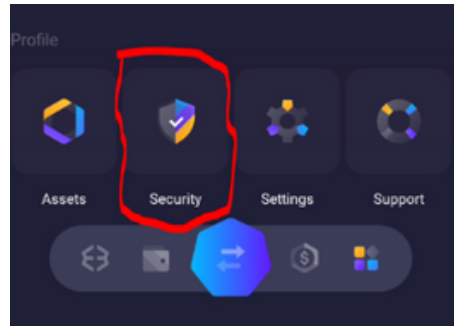
How to secure and backup your Exodus wallet with a password and secret 12-word phrase

Note: if you already have an Exodus wallet, skip down to the section “How to restore an existing Exodus wallet on mobile”.

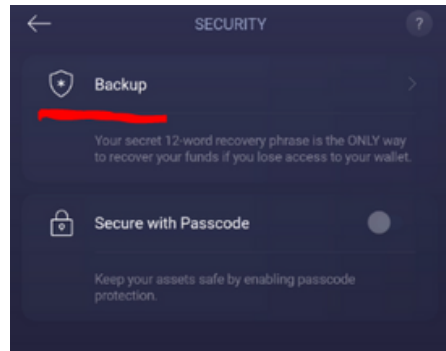
Step 1: Click the icon with the 4 little boxes in a square shape in the bottom right-hand corner of the small menu at the bottom of your screen in the app to go to the “Profile” section of the app.



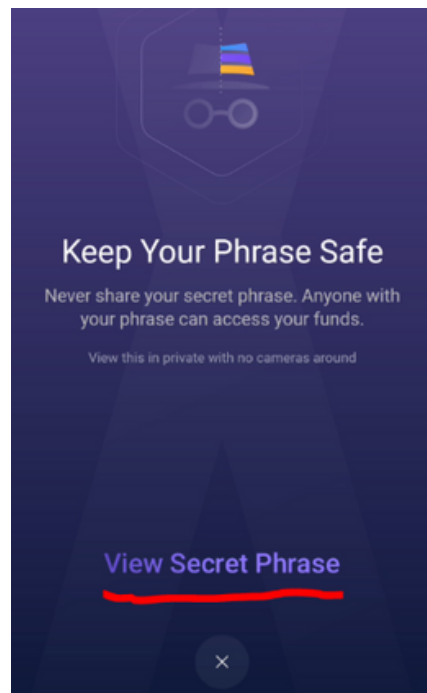
Step 2: Click on “Security”



Step 3: Click on “Backup” to view and record your 12-word recovery phrase



Step 4: “View Secret Phrase”

Step 5: Follow directions on the app to reveal the secret phrase. For app security reasons, we were unable to take screenshots of this portion of the setup.

What we recommend doing here is grabbing a notebook or sheet of paper and a pen. Set your phone on a table or desk. Have your pen ready with your writing hand. Then, with your thumb or index finger in your non-writing hand, press on the words that read “Press and Hold to Reveal.”

You’ll see your secret phrase numbered 1-12.

Write down your secret phrase from 1-12 IN ORDER on your sheet of paper or notebook.

Treat this passphrase as if it’s a giant stack of cash you want to keep hidden. It’s recommended to store your 12-word seed phrase in a safe or similar hiding place for maximum security and safety. Ideally in a fireproof and waterproof safe.

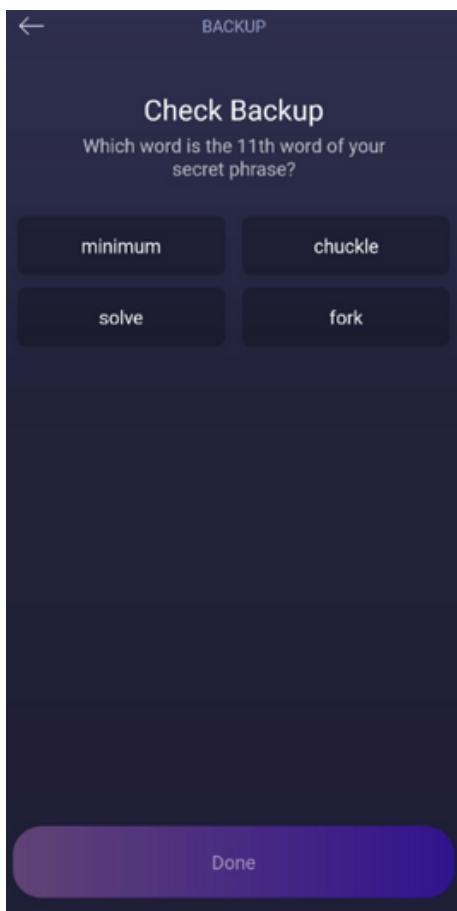
Once you’ve written down your 12-word phrase, double check you’ve written it correctly from 1-12 and spelled each word correctly.

Then click “Done.”

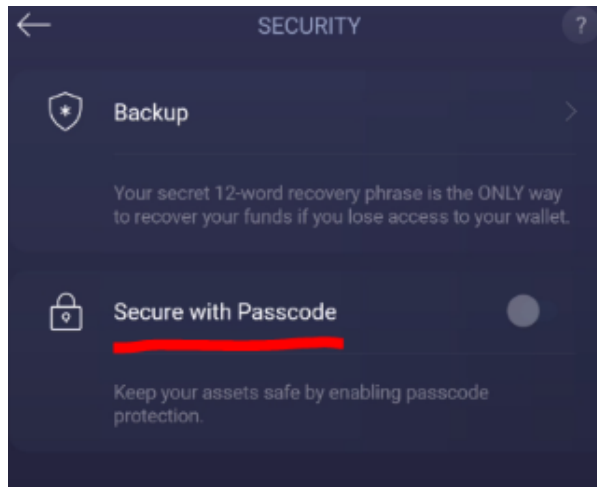
Step 6: Follow instructions to “Check Backup”

Note: the app will ask you to recall one random word from the sequence. You must answer correctly to continue. In this example, the app asked us for the 11th word.

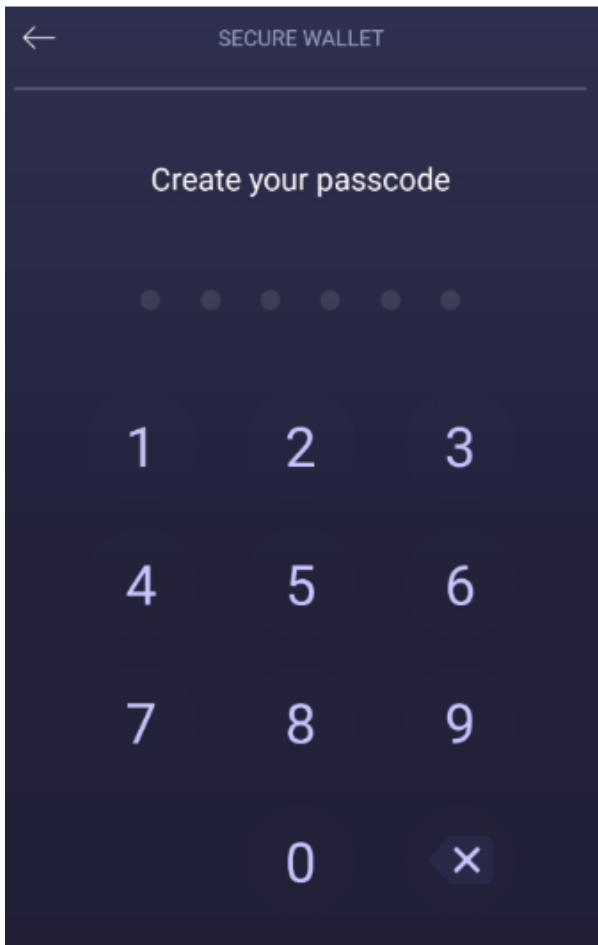
Choose the correct word then click “Done”.



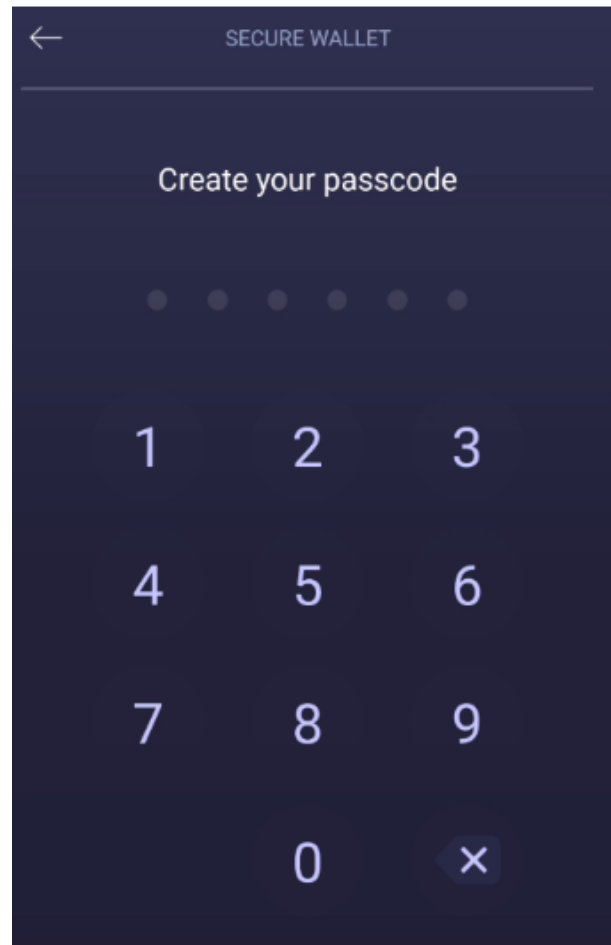
Step 7: Now you should be back at the Security screen again. To set your passcode, click “Secure with Passcode”.



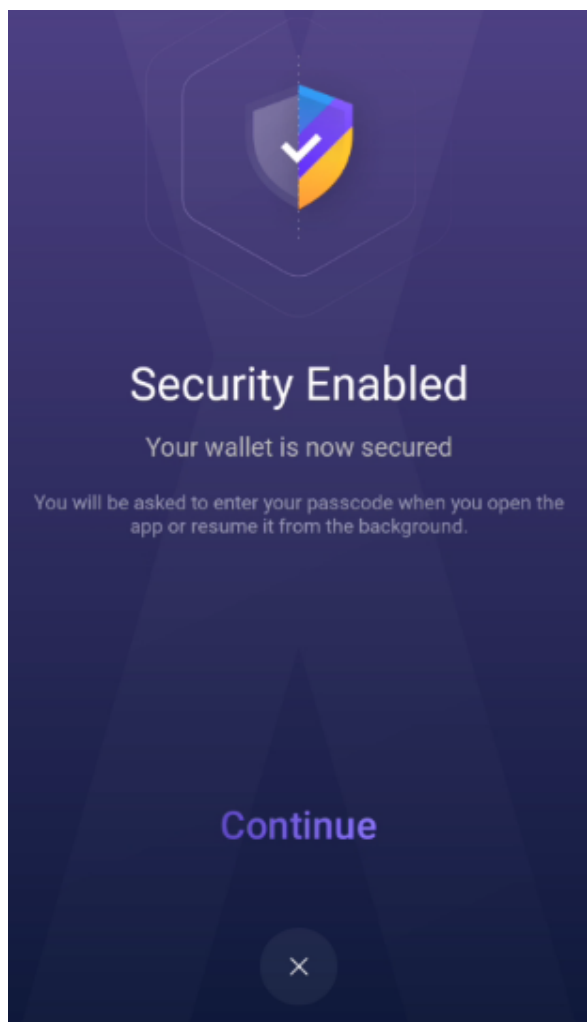
Step 8: Enter a 6-digit passcode



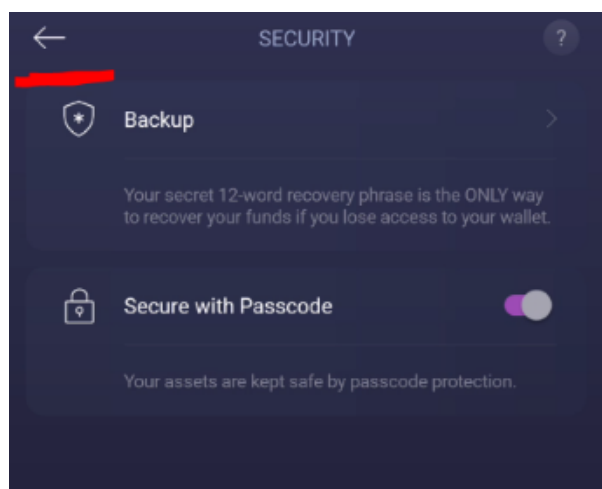
Step 9: Re-enter THE SAME 6-digit passcode to confirm



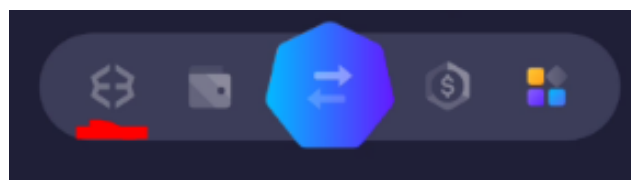
Step 10: Your wallet is now secured! Click “Continue”.



Step 11: Click the back arrow to return to the Profile section of the app.



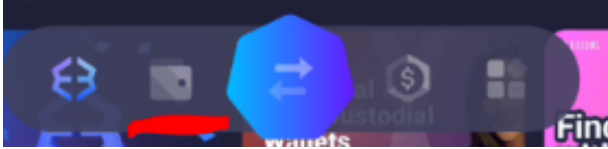
Step 12: Click on the Exodus symbol in the lower left-hand corner of the small menu at the bottom of the app to return to the home screen.



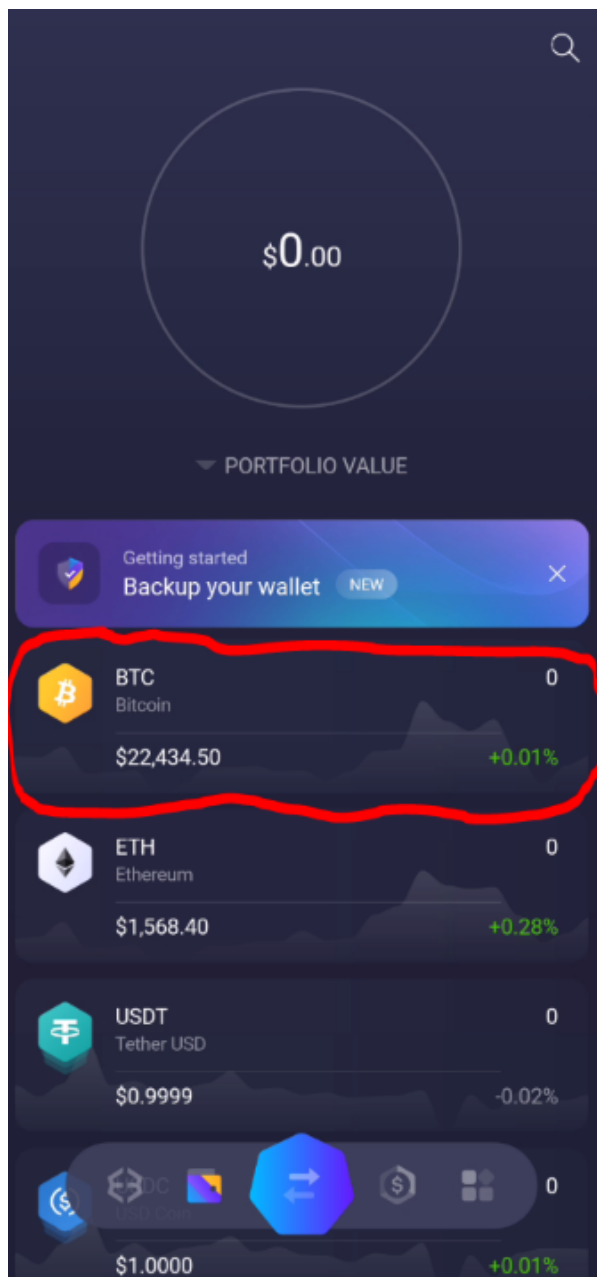
How to receive crypto into your mobile Exodus wallet

Note: for this tutorial, we're going to use Bitcoin but the steps are the same for all cryptocurrencies in your wallet

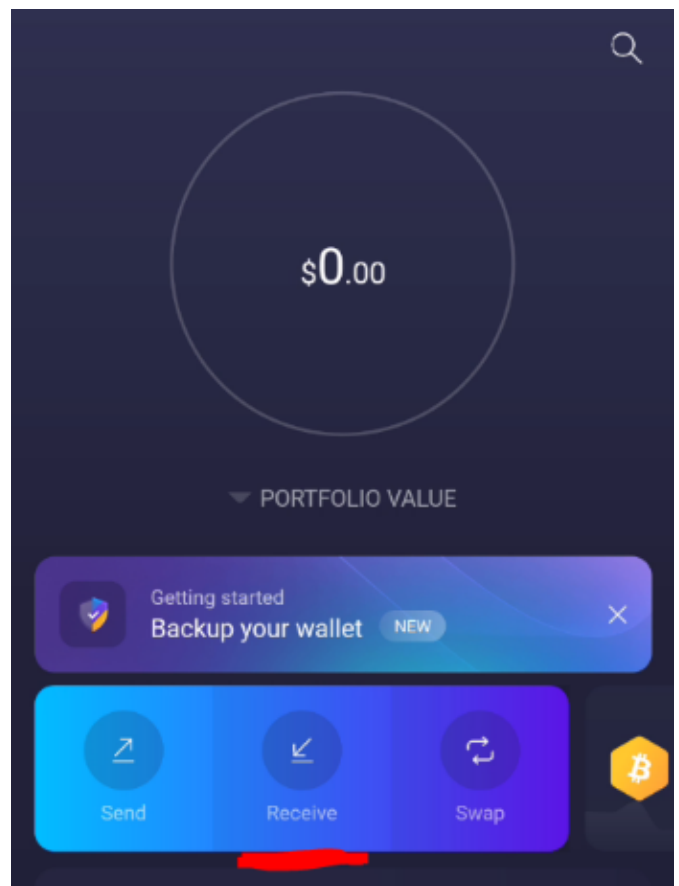
Step 1: Click on the wallet icon



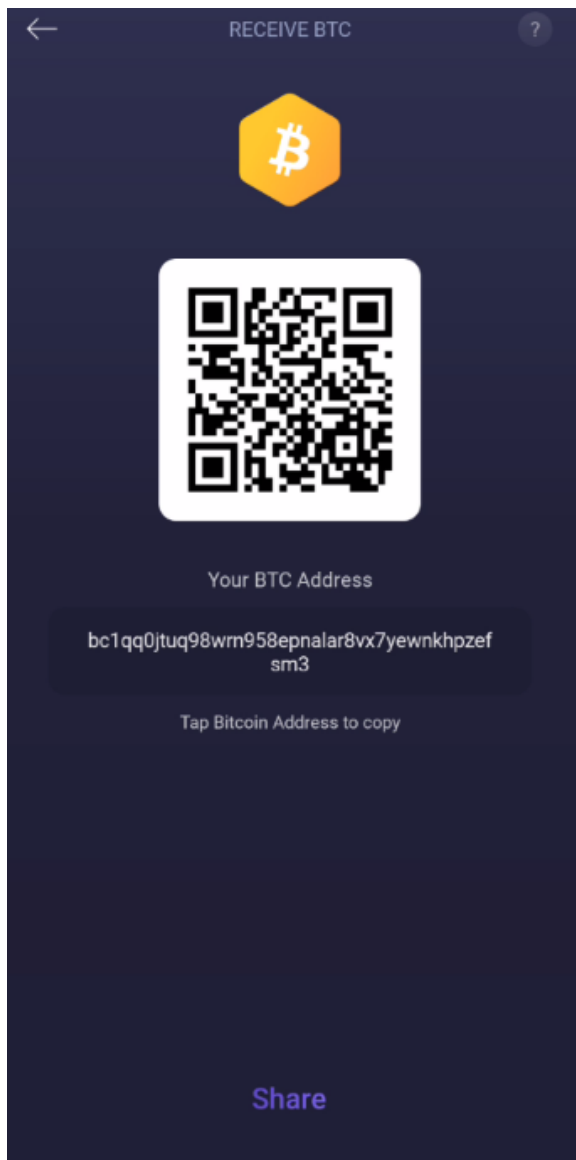
Step 2: Click on the Bitcoin or BTC option in the menu of cryptocurrencies



Step 3: Click on "Receive"



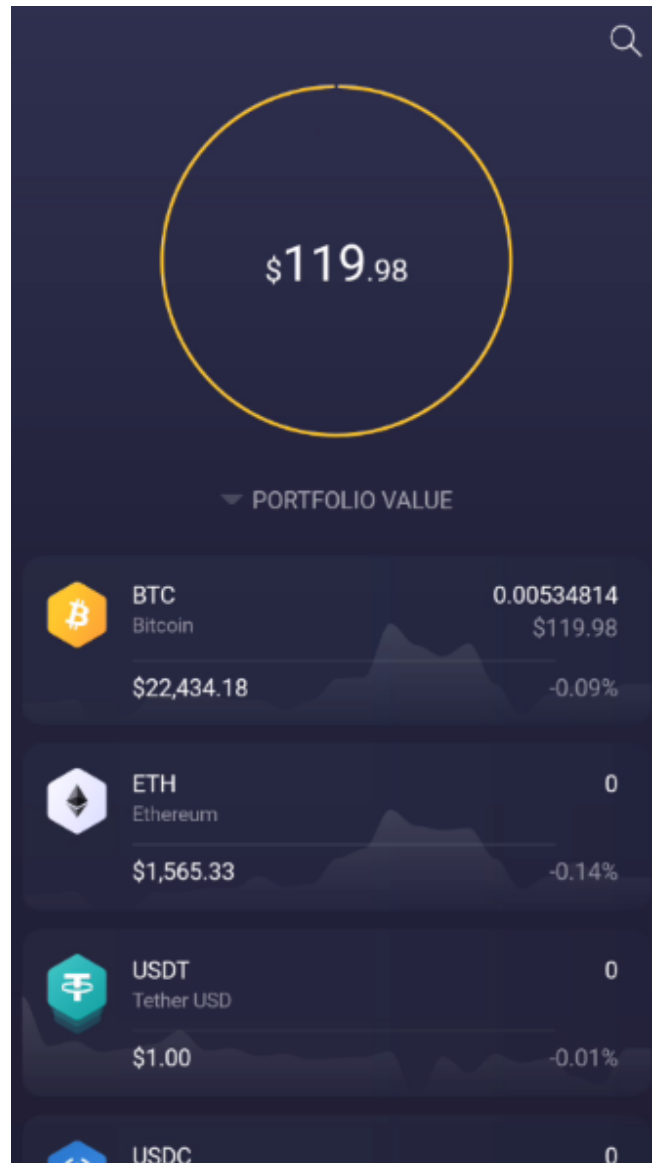
Step 4: Copy your BTC address by tapping on it.



Step 5: Paste your BTC address wherever you need to in order to receive BTC from a sender. To paste on a mobile phone hold your finger down for a moment on the field you want to paste the address to.

For example, you could paste this address into a cryptocurrency exchange such as Coinbase to receive BTC. Or you could give this address to a person who can send you BTC from their wallet.

Step 6: You should receive your BTC almost immediately, depending on how many transactions are currently happening on the network. After you receive the BTC it usually takes around 10 minutes to confirm.

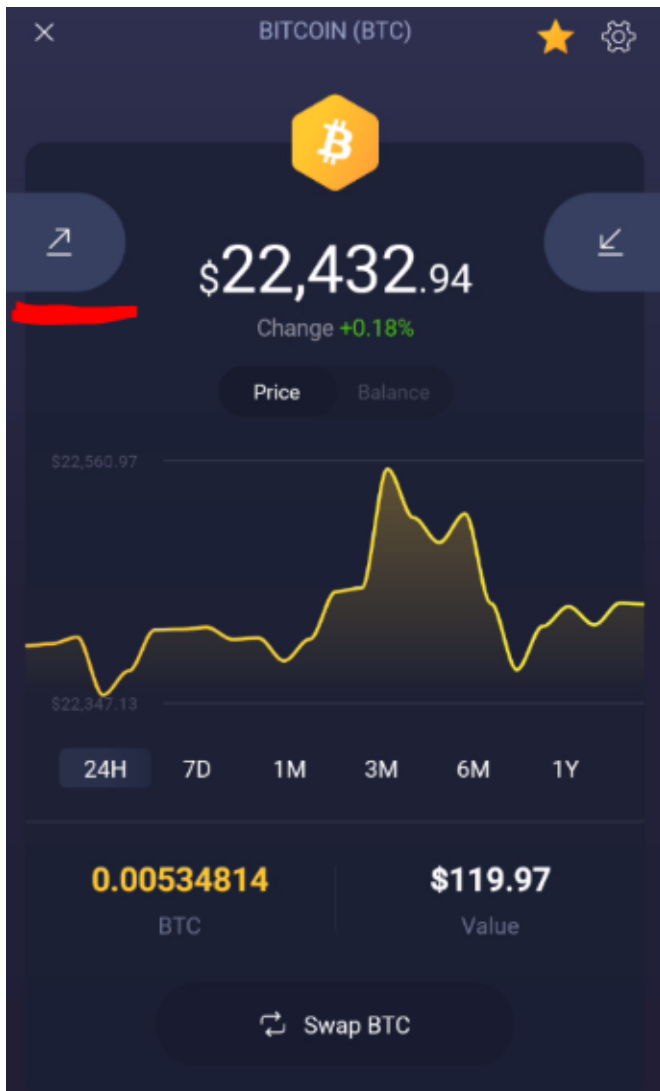

How to send crypto from your Exodus wallet

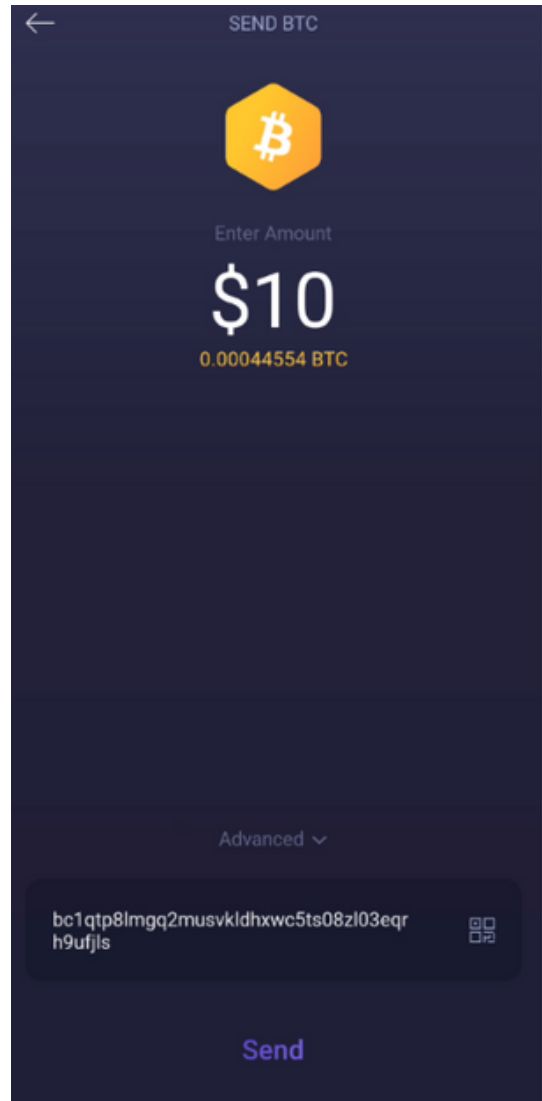
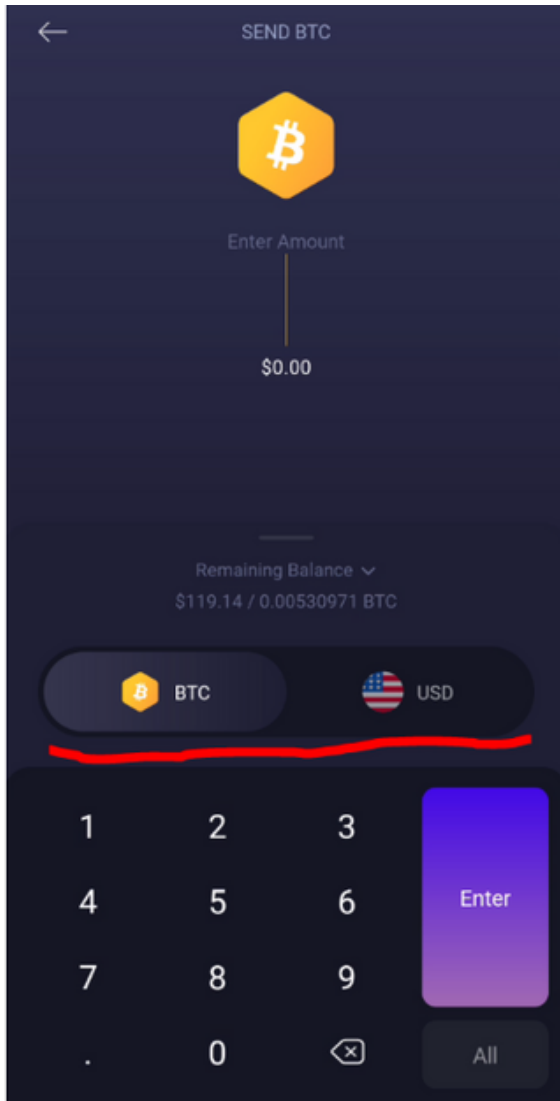
Note: for this tutorial, we're going to use Bitcoin but the steps are the same for all cryptocurrencies in your wallet

Step 1: Go to the cryptocurrency in your wallet you want to send (in this case, Bitcoin) and click on the “Send” button, which is the arrow in the upper left part of the screen pointing upward.



Step 2: Input the exact amount of either the BTC you want to send or the USD (select either BTC or USD to input the amount you want to send).

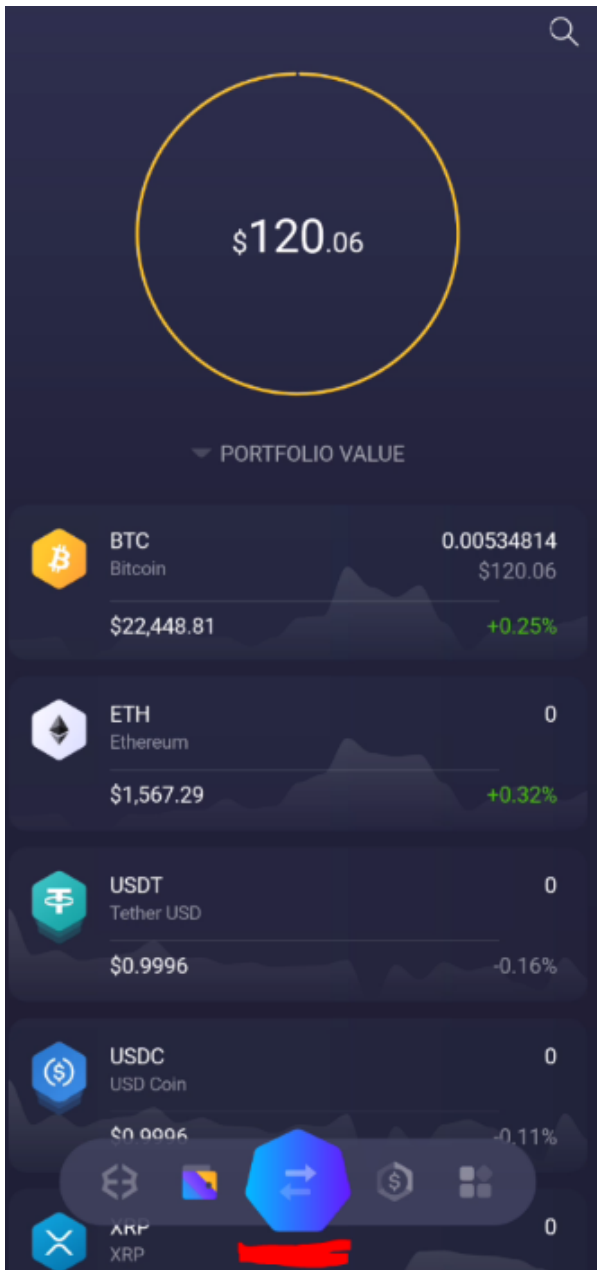
Note: if you input a certain amount in USD, the Exodus wallet will automatically update the BTC amount and vice versa



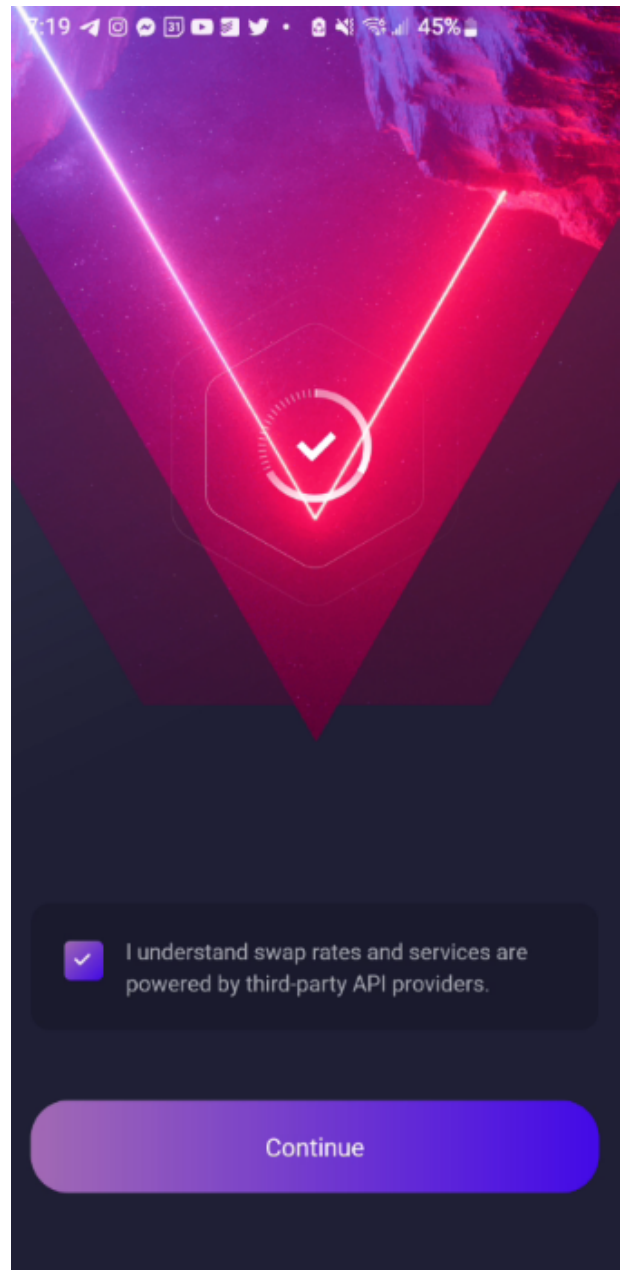
Step 3: Click "Send"

How to “swap” or trade one cryptocurrency for another inside of the Exodus wallet

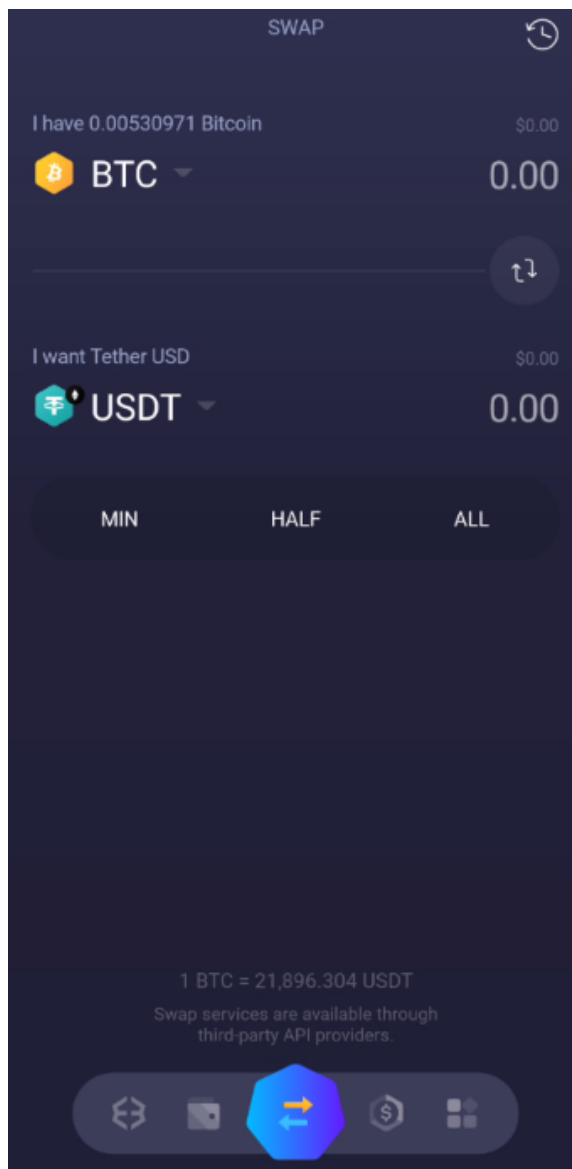
Step 1: Click the “Swap” icon on the small menu at the bottom of the screen, which is located right in the middle.



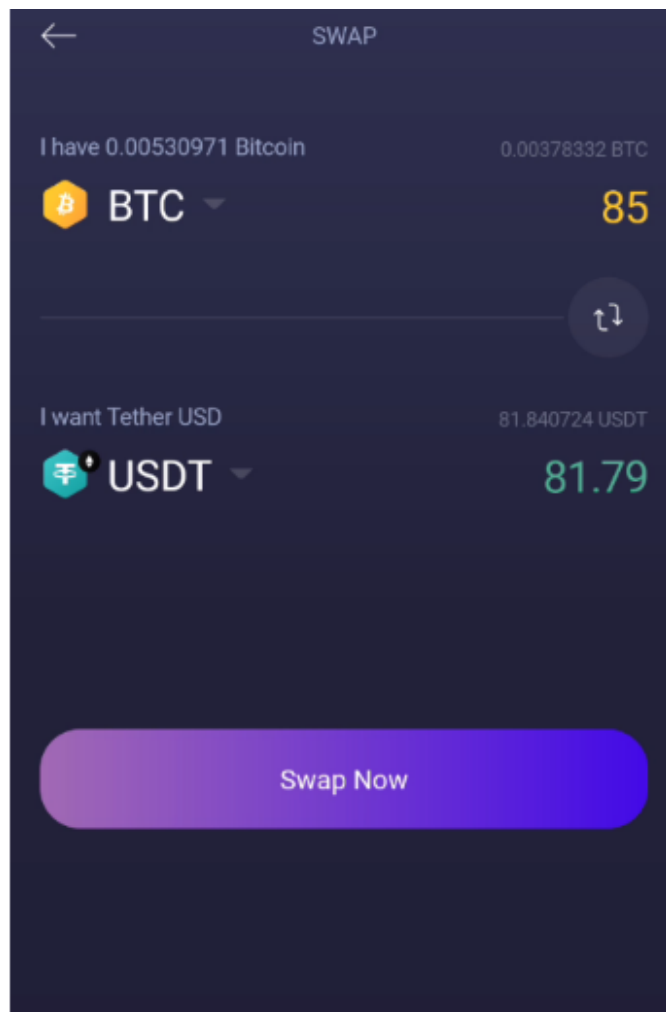
Step 2: Check the checkbox for permission and click “Continue”.



Step 3: Select the cryptocurrency you want to swap (that's the crypto at the top of the screen) and then select the cryptocurrency you want in exchange for it (that's the crypto below it).



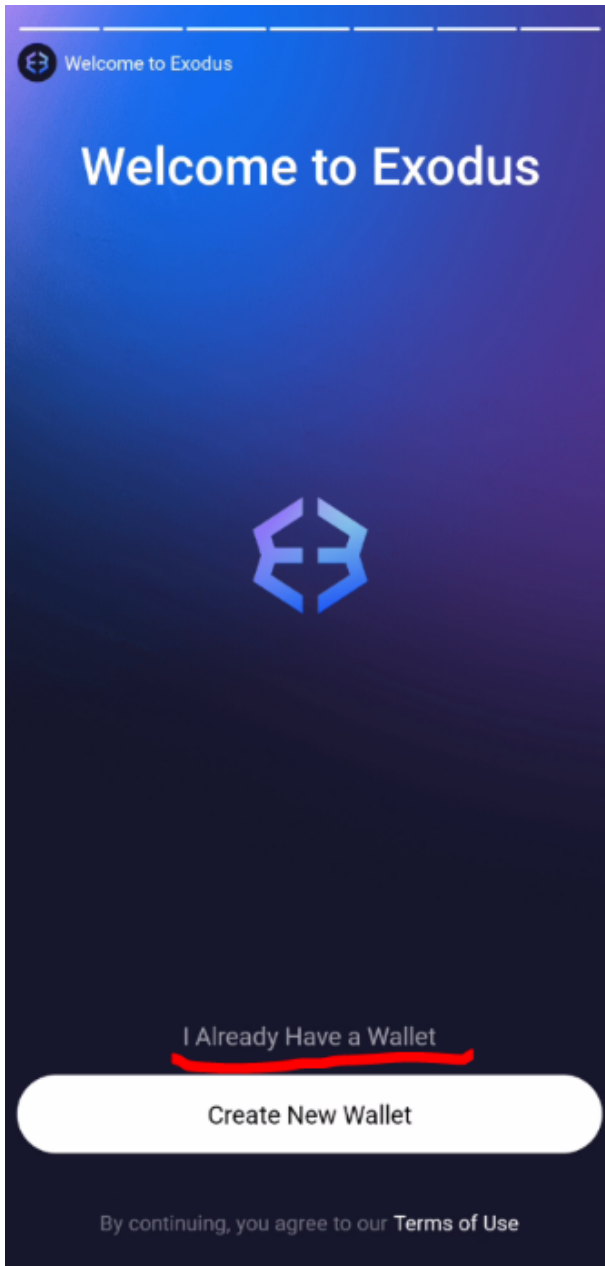
Step 4: Enter the amount of crypto you're swapping from one to the other and click "Swap Now"



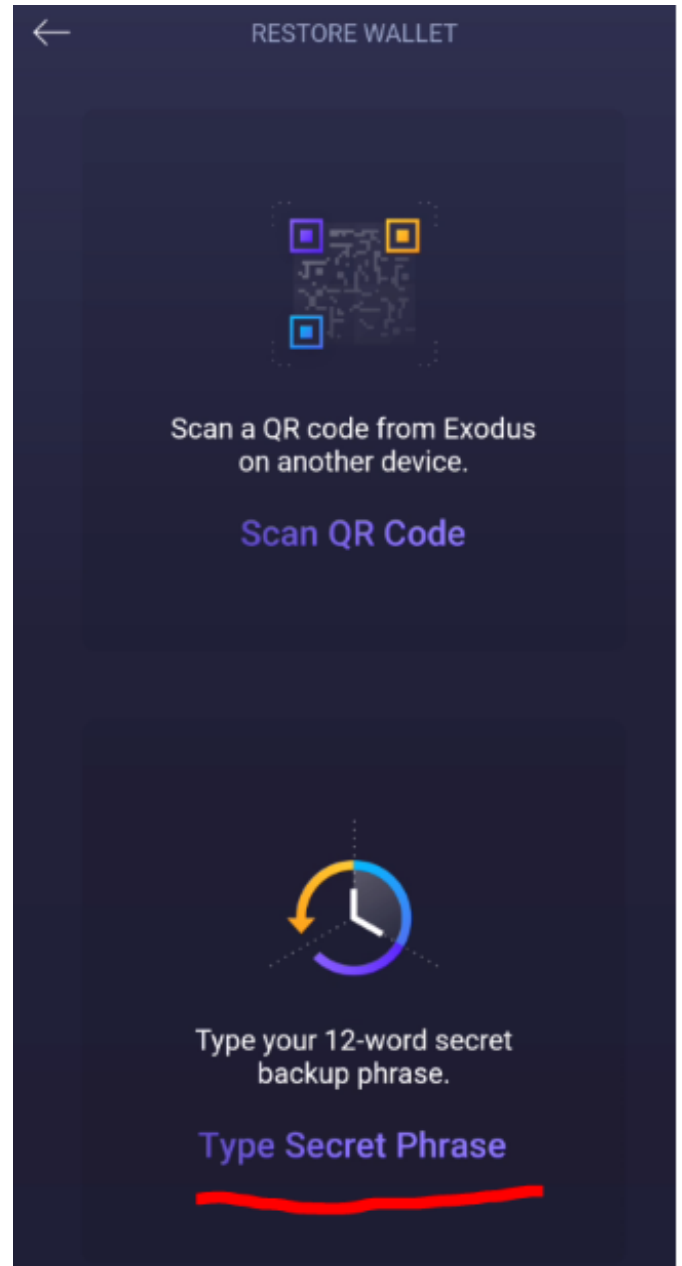
Step 5: Wait for the swap to be complete! The funds will be automatically found in your wallet.

How to restore an existing Exodus wallet on mobile

Step 1: Open the Exodus wallet after downloading it to your mobile phone and click “I Already Have a Wallet”.

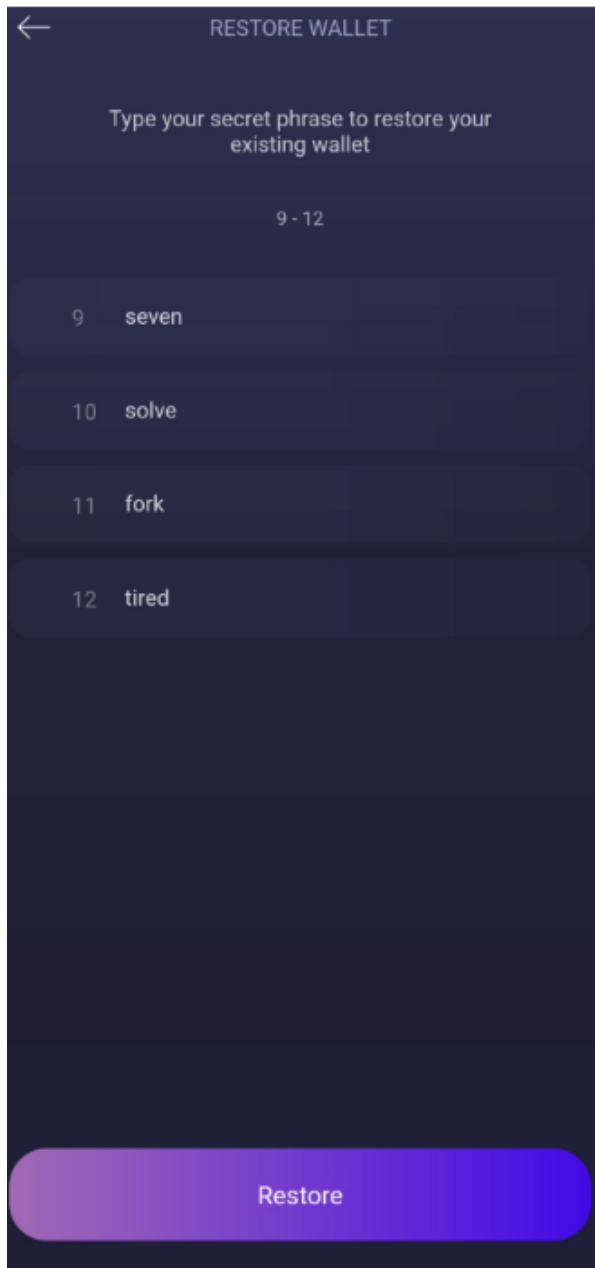


Step 2: Click “Type your 12-word secret backup phrase”.



How to restore an existing Exodus wallet on mobile

Step 3: Enter your secret phrase from 1-12 IN ORDER then click “Restore”



Step 4: A popup box will appear after clicking “Restore”. Click “Continue and Restart” and wait a few minutes as your Exodus wallet is restored on your mobile device. Once it's done, Exodus will tell you “Restore Successful!”
